



Guidance: Volunteer Louisiana Request For Proposal (RFP) Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 AmeriCorps State Grants

State Formula Process for New and Continuation Applicants

The Volunteer Louisiana Commission awards and administers federal grants from the AmeriCorps agency. AmeriCorps grants are awarded to eligible organizations proposing to engage AmeriCorps members in evidence-based or evidence-informed interventions/practices to strengthen communities through an approved national service position. Members may receive a living allowance and other benefits while serving. Upon successful completion of their service, members earn a Segal AmeriCorps Education Award from the National Service Trust that members can use to pay for higher education expenses or apply to qualified student loans.

RFP Timeline

Volunteer Louisiana invites current subgrantees and new organizations to apply for AmeriCorps funding through one of two processes. New applicants, as well as all current AmeriCorps State Formula programs applying as a continuation, will apply through the State Formula application process and timeline outlined in this RFP packet.

All current National Competitive programs, as well as State Formula programs applying as a recompete, will apply through the National Competitive Application Process described in the FY 2024 ASN Competitive Louisiana RFP document available on the Volunteer Louisiana Grant Opportunities page: https://volunteerlouisiana.gov/grant-opportunities

These RFPs are applicable to organizations that propose to place AmeriCorps members in service solely within Louisiana. If you are a national or multi-state applicant, please refer to the <u>AmeriCorps' National</u> list of Funding Opportunities.
